Interview Information:

- 1. When you first arrive at the District Office, please check in with Mariah Zimmerman, Executive Assistant.
- 2. You are encouraged to dress in business casual attire.
- 3. You are welcome to use a printed Bible during your interview (printed format, not digital format.)
- 4. If applying for Ordination (and Married) we request that your spouse attend the interview with you.

The procedure for your interviews will include meeting with:

- The Ministerial Studies Board
 - To review your transcripts
 - Review courses you completed in the past year
 - Verify your current placement within the Course of Study
 - Review your current mentoring relationship
 - If you are a graduate of the course of study your interview will include an update of your ongoing academic development for ministry.
- The Ministerial Credentials Board
 - To consider your application for a district license or ordination,, and to evaluate your personal
 and ministry development in the past year. This is the Board who will be listening to your
 presentation on the Articles of Faith and asking you the "Interview Guideline" questions which
 are included as a link in this document.

As a student in the Course of Study please be ready to identify a Mentor (local pastor or other ordained minister), with whom you have met with in the past 12 months, and plan to meet in the coming 12 months to continue developing your personal accountability and spiritual purity.

If you are granted your first district license in this interview we request that you make arrangements to attend the Ordination Service on Saturday, May 3, 2025 at Hope Point in Yuba City, 600 N. George Washington Blvd. Yuba City 95993. This is where you will be presented with your first District License.

Please notify the district office if you have a change of personal contact information at any time. This includes address, phone, email, church, assigned role, ect.

If for any reason you experience significant travel delays or weather conditions prohibit you from getting to your scheduled interview, please call Mariah Zimmerman as soon as possible. If needed we will attempt to reschedule your interview time.
