Dr. Jerry Porter is a general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene, elected in June 1997.

Following his first pastorate, the Porters were appointed missionaries to the Dominican Republic, followed by an assignment to San Jose, Costa Rica, where he served as rector of the Nazarene Seminary of the Americas. He served as regional director for the Mexico/Central America Region from 1986 to 1992, when he was elected district superintendent of the Mid-Atlantic District.

Dr. Porter has written various publications in Nazarene journals and is known primarily as a missionary evangelist.

Jerry married the former Toni Dubs, both graduates of Bethany Nazarene College (now Southern Nazarene University).

The Porters were blessed with two children, Amy Jo and William Britt. Amy passed away in 1995 from cancer. The Porters live in Florida. Their son, Bill and his wife, Kristen, live in Fort Worth, Texas.

The Sacramento District Family Camp is held at Diamond Arrow Christian Conference Center in Nevada City, CA. Services are held in an outdoor amphitheater in the morning and evening with afternoon free time. There are separate children's services both morning and night, and a separate youth service in the morning.

There are a variety of lodging choices: tent camping, cabins (a few with bathrooms), dorm, motel room, and RV sites.

You may buy your meals in the cafeteria or prepare your own meals (campfires and barbecues are NOT permitted). There is also no food allowed in the motel rooms.

There is a ropes course, swimming pool, and rock climbing on the grounds. Other activities are also planned.

Nearby attractions include Malakof Diggins State Historical Park, Empire Mine State Historic Park, shopping in historic Nevada City and Grass Valley, and the Yuba River.
