## **HOW CAN MY CHURCH BE A LIFELINE CHURCH?**

- Envision a **new** Church community, OR **create** a dynamic new ministry that reaches people!
- **Share** the vision and needs with potential partners in your church or region of the district
- Create an action plan for the vision through **prayer** by completing the following steps:
  - 1) **DESIGN** the focus of the new ministry with projected outcomes in your local community
  - 2) **RECRUIT, ASSESS & DEVELOP** a leadership team of gifted, ALL-IN leaders
  - 3) **IDENTIFY** the church(es) who will help sponsor, birth, and nurture the vision
  - 4) **DEVELOP** financial resources
  - 5) **CREATE** strategic ministries at the heart of the new ministry's mission
  - 6) **ESTABLISH** an objective source of accountability for your leadership team
  - 7) **PROVIDE** a complete report of current finances of the host church(es)
  - 8) **SUBMIT** a LIFELINE Application to the District Advisory Board to be considered for a LIFELINE Grant.
