2023

The Sacramento District Advisory Board typically met for regular bi-monthly meetings on the 2nd or 3rd Thursday during the 2022-2023 church year, in March, May, July, September, November, and January. All meetings were held at the Loomis District Office, or in hybrid settings. Email communication and ZOOM interaction allowed the Board to address necessary agenda items as needed throughout the year.

The DAB serves to support and advise the District Superintendent. The DAB also serves as the District Church Properties Board, as approved annually by the District Assembly in compliance with the Manual of the Church of the Nazarene (2017-2021: paragraph 236), upon the approval of this report.

The Sacramento District Investment Committee serves as an auxiliary of the District Advisory Board to review the District's investment portfolio that is managed by Green Wealth Management/LPL Financial (Folsom, CA) and Van Hulzen Asset Management/TD Ameritrade (El Dorado Hills, CA).

All action items approved by the DAB have been recorded in minutes open to review and are on file in the District Office, 6235 S. Walnut Street, Suite 200, Loomis, California. The significant agenda and **ACTION** items of the District Advisory Board for the 2022-2023 Assembly year included the following:

- ◆ review and approval of the Minutes for all meeting(s) and action items
- ◆ review and approval of the monthly/year to date District Treasurer's Reports
- ◆ election of Joe McCoy as corporate Secretary of the Sacramento DAB for 2022-2023.
- ◆ approval of Kaitlin Peoples/District Executive Assistant to serve as recording secretary of DAB meetings unless certain issues or agenda items deem it inappropriate as a District employee
- ◆ approval of the following items relative to local church ministries on the Sacramento District:
 - \$65,000.00 annual Lifeline Grant (concluding 5/25/23) for pastoral compensation, WoodlandCenterPointe
 - \$3,500.00 monthly Lifeline Grant (concluded as of 1/25/23) for lease of ministry property for Shasta Lake Branches Community
 - approval for Susanville Church to purchase adjacent property for development
 - \$90,000.00 one-time Lifeline Grant for property improvements for Marysville The Crossing
 - approval for Sacramento Arden Church to sell portion of land to Sacramento County
 - approval to declare West Sacramento Southport Church in crisis, and to sell the current property, with proceeds to be determined based on long term feasibility of the church; and to approve district financial assistance until sale of the property, to be repaid to the District upon the sale of the church
 - approval of a no interest bridge loan for Mt. Shasta of up to \$15,000.00 to be dispersed as needed and reviewed monthly, to be repaid to the District upon the sale of the parsonage
 - approval of a LIFELINE Grant of up to \$250,000.00 for major refurbishing/remodel of Sacramento Community Church
- ◆ approval to hire Bonnie Marroquin, Dist Office Admin Assistant, annual salary of \$62,500.00

- ◆ approval to increase district ministries mileage reimbursement rate to .585/mile
- ◆ action to terminate current lease on 9001 Foothills Blvd., Suites 130-140, Roseville CA
- ◆ action to remove Church Type Mission status of Alturas GracePoint to inactive status
- ◆ action to discontinue services of the Mt. Shasta Church indefinitely
- ◆ action to officially declare Willows Church as inactive
- ◆ approval of a 6-month lease to Colusa County Ministerial Association for compassionate ministry use of the Willows Church property
- ◆ action to increase District North Lake Tahoe condo use fees by \$50.00 per one week rental term
- ◆ approval of up to \$30,000.00 Lifeline Grant to Auburn Parkside for assistance with litigation fees
- ◆ approval of 3-week sabbatical for District Office Executive Assistant, Kaitlin Peoples for 8 years of continuous service to the Sacramento District
- ◆ approval of the location for The Reunion, 2023 of Yuba City Hope Point Church
- ◆ approval of a new location for Pastoral Team Retreat at Palisades Tahoe (formerly Squaw Valley) for September 25-27, 2023
- ◆ approval for the sale of the Willows Church parsonage
- ◆ approval for a Lifeline Grant of \$173,000.00 for new church start – Revive Church, Plumas Lake
- ◆ renewal of an approved policy for the Sacramento District to give the minimum required contribution on behalf of local churches on the Sacramento District Church of the Nazarene, in order to participate in the Nazarene Pension and Benefit program for the Church of the Nazarene, for the benefit of all full-time eligible ministers, as defined by Pensions & Benefits USA, and to also encourage each local Church Board to be proactive in achieving their annual Nazarene Pension & Benefit giving goal. Current fiscal impact: \$2,900.00 (1 year).
